¶ Only appearance of Reynolds important medical studies on marijuana. “In order to furnish the results to which I have been led by more than thirty years’ experience of the drug, it will be well to arrange the maladies in which it has been either useful, or useless... by giving my experience of the great value of Indian hemp.” John Russell Reynolds (1828-1896), FRS and personal physician to Queen Victoria, published this seminal article in *The Lancet* on March 22, 1890 in which he summarised his experience of the therapeutic use of cannabis, asserted its efficacy in cases of migraine, various epileptic conditions, depression, asthma, and dysmenorrhoea, and concluded “by giving his opinion of the great value of Indian hemp and considered it “one of the most valuable medicines we possess.” According to Reynolds indian hemp remained effective as an analgesic for months and even years without an increase in the dosage.Price: USD 500.00
